



Course Application Policy

Each course run by BCTS has its own pre-requisites in order to be eligible for the training. Please see each course page of the website and associated brochure.

Level 2 and Level 3 CPCAB Counselling courses

- Application form to be completed and submitted
- Attendance at interview
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- Both of the above to be successful for a place to be offered on the course
- Offers are conditional on the previous level course being passed.

BCTS hold the right to withdraw an offer from the applicant should any of the following be experienced:-

- The fitness to study policy is implemented for the student on their current training at time of application and up til the applied for course commencing, e.g. a L2 student applying for the L3 training
- New information coming to light about the applicant which demonstrates the applicant is no longer eligible for the course e.g. feedback/reference from course tutor
- The applicant bringing the centre into disrepute e.g. on social media
- The applicant in breach of the BACP ethical framework. This may include disrespectful communication with BCTS and their tutors

Level 4 CPCAB counselling training

- Application form to be completed and submitted
- Attendance at interview
- Level 3 Tutor reference. *Please note that it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the tutor reference is submitted at the time of the application.*

- All of the above to be successful for a place to be offered on the course
- Offers are conditional on the Level 3 Counselling training being passed

BCTS hold the right to withdraw an offer from the applicant should any of the following be experienced:-

- The fitness to study policy is implemented for the student on their current training at time of application and up til the applied for course commencing, e.g. a L3 student applying for the L4 training
- New information coming to light about the applicant which demonstrates the applicant is no longer eligible for the course e.g. feedback/reference from course tutor
- The applicant bringing the centre into disrepute e.g. on social media
- The applicant in breach of the BACP ethical framework. This may include disrespectful communication with BCTS and their tutors

Level 5 and 6 CPCAB counselling / supervision training

- Application form to be completed and submitted
- Attendance at interview
- Supervisor reference. *Please note that it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the supervisor reference is submitted at the time of the application.*
- All of the above to be successful for a place to be offered on the course
